



Announcement FDA 4/2019

The selection of athletes to participate in the WFDF 2019 Asia Oceanic Ultimate and Guts Championships, Shanghai, People Republic of China

The World Flying Disc Federation (WFDF) has sent a letter inviting the Flying Disc Association to send Thailand teams to participate in the WFDF 2019 Asia Oceanic Ultimate and Guts Competition in 2019 in Shanghai People's Republic of China During July 23-27, 2019, the Flying Disc Association would like to send a team to participate in the Ultimate Mixed Team Division.

The Flying Disc Association (FDA), therefore, invites the athletes, who is a member of clubs registering as a regular member of FDA to apply for a tryout and selection. The athletes must comply with certain conditions set by FDA throughout the selection process, training, and competition. Interested athletes can send their intention to participate in the selection by filling in the notification form as attached to the email: issadee@gmail.com by 24 March 2019

In order to select and prepare the team to participate in the competition successfully, FDA would like to set the conditions and regulations as an agreement between the FDA and the athletes who will participate in the program.

1. Athletes must be members of the club / member club registered with FDA in year 2019
2. Athletes meet the requirements of the WFDF to participate in the competition according to the latest announcements of the WFDF.

D1.5. Player Classes – All players on a National Team Roster must belong to one of the following classes:

D1.5.1. Legal Citizen - Players are deemed to be "Legal citizens" if they own a passport or equivalent legal document issued by the country's government

D1.5.2. WFDF Citizen - Players are also deemed to be "WFDF citizens" if they have moved to the country at least four (4) years prior to the start date of the event and spent more than 75% of those four (4) years in the country.

D1.5.3. Resident Non-Citizen - Players are deemed to be "Resident non-citizens" if they own a legal certificate of permanent residency issued by the country's government; or if they have moved to the country at least twenty (20) months prior to the start date of the event and spent more than 75% of those twenty (20) months in the country.

D1.5.4. Ultimate Community Member (**NOTE: THIS RULE IS UNDER REVIEW AND MAY BE CHANGED FOR EVENTS AFTER 2018**) - Players are deemed to be "Ultimate community members" at the discretion of the National Association if they are considered to be a significant part of that Country's ultimate community, but do not fall under the above categories. The following may be taken into account by the National Association in making this decision:

D1.5.4.1. Residency history in that Country

D1.5.4.2. Participation in that Country's ultimate events, especially national championships

D1.5.4.3. Past representation on National Teams

D1.5.4.4. Participation in the development of ultimate in the Country

At the time of registration, National Associations must make public a list of any players who are Ultimate Community Members, and the reason/s for doing so.

D1.6. Team Roster Composition – A National Team may have on its roster:

D1.6.1. any number of Legal Citizens or WFDF Citizens

D1.6.2. a maximum of four (4) Resident Non-Citizens

D1.6.3. a maximum of one (1) Ultimate Community Member replacing one of the Resident Non- Citizens

3. When the FDA announces the results of the selection of athletes, then it is final. In the case that the athlete decides to withdraw, the FDA will hold the right to announce additional athletes to replace as appropriate.

4. Athletes wishing to withdraw after 17 May 2562 onwards, athletes will be able to withdraw only in the case of injury, with a medical certificate.

5. FDA will be responsible for the following expenses:

5.1 Team Fee

5.2 Application fees for athletes and staff (Player Fee)

5.3 International travel expenses

5.4 Travel expenses within the People's Republic of China between airports, venue and accommodation

5.5 Visa fees

5.6 Travel Insurance

5.7 Food and accommodation expenses during travel to compete in the People's Republic of China

5.8 Competition and practice uniform (jerseys, shorts, short socks, training uniform and track suit)

5.9 Accommodation fees during training sessions, food, and practice rent during training sessions

6. Athletes will be responsible for the costs of traveling back and forth between accommodation in Thailand and the airport, including traveling to practice
7. Athletes must be responsible for issuing their own Passport with an expiration date of Passport not less than 6 months from July 23, 2019.

9. FDA will announce the names of the athletes selection committee, selection criteria including the list of team manager and coaching staff during selection, practice and traveling to the competition

Draft conditions in the case of being selected as athletes representing the FDA.

1. Athletes representing the association must stay in accommodation provided by FDA
2. FDA will issue a certificate to represent the FDA for athletes participating in the competition.
3. Athletes representing the association must play the best of their abilities in the competition and training. The athletes need to follow the instructions of team manager and coaching staff appointed by the association. The athletes need to attend the practice at least 80 percent, if the athlete cannot attend the training or competition must have prior clearance/approval by the coaches.
4. Athletes representing the association must follow the competition rules of WFDF, organizers and regulations of FDA.

5. Athletes representing the association must notify the association when sick, injury or of any necessity, that hinders the ability to play.
6. Athletes representing the association must not be in place, which the association considers to be an inappropriate place during practice and travel to participate in the competition.
7. Athletes representing the association must allow the FDA to take pictures, video clip for public relations for the association. The athletes need to comply with FDA sponsorship guidelines and wear clothes and uniforms that the FDA selected during the practice, competition and traveling.
8. FDA can cancel travel to participate in the competition in the case that the FDA has force majeure by notifying the athlete at least 7 days before the departure date.
9. If the athlete representing the association violates the regulation set by FDA, the association can cancel the right to participate in the competition by recording the fault report. The athlete has the right to appeal by sending to appeal to the FDA or SAT.
